Jheryl Busby, a veteran of 20 years in the music industry, got his start at Stax Records in the

early 1970's and later, as the first president of the newly created Black music division at MCA Records. He became part owner, president and chief executive officer of Motown Record Company L.P., in July 1988 after Motown founder Berry Gordy sold the legendary com-

pany. Under Busby's leadership, Motwon has launched three new record labels. Burt Manning has served in a number of capacities during his tenure with J. Walter Thompson: vice chairman with worldwide responsibility; chairman and chief operating officer of J. Wal-

ter Thompson USA and most recently, its chairman and chief executive officer, a position he has held since July 1987. Under his leadership, J. Walter Thompson has doubled its billing and revenues, making it the largest advertising agency in the country.

Melvin Lindsey, pioneer of the "quiet storm" radio format, died Thursday in Washington, D.C., from complications caused by AIDS. He was 36. While at Howard University in the mid-70s, he created the evening format specializing in R&B ballads and lights fusion. It caught on at stations across the country. In 1990, he gained national attention as co-host of Black Entertainment Television's *Screen Scene*, an entertainment news show.
