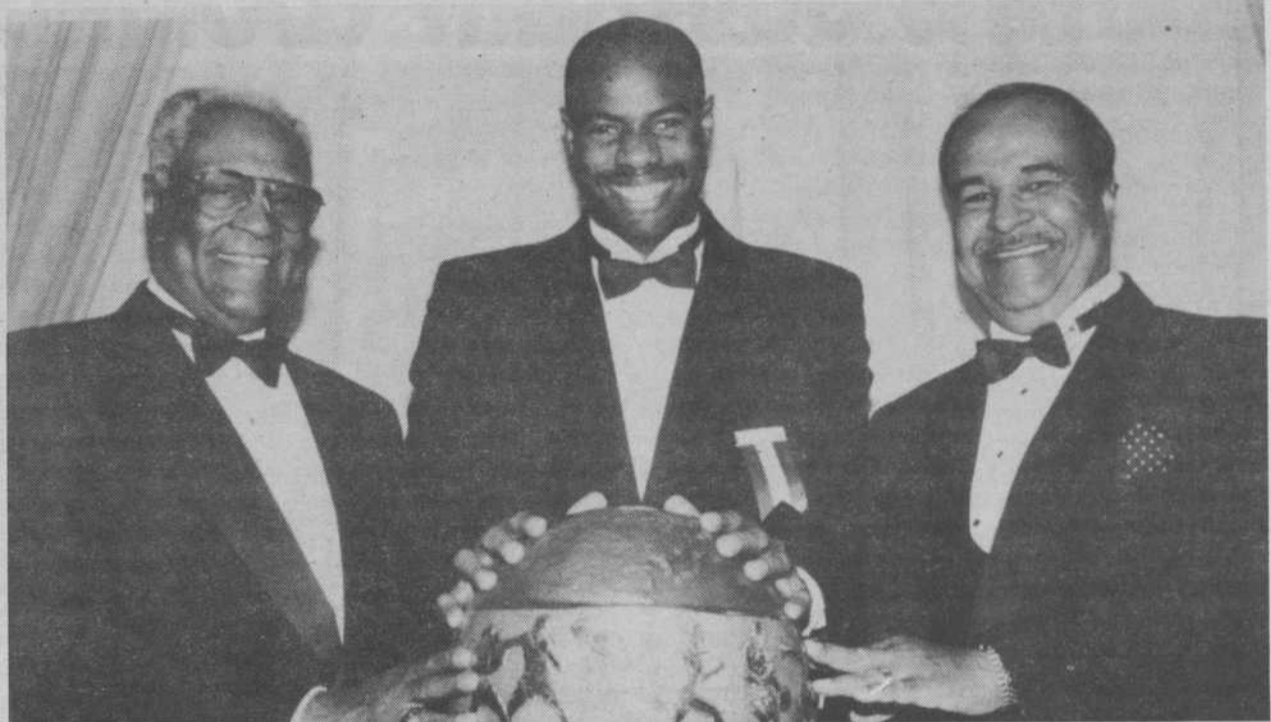
Long Jump world record holder, Mike Powell of Los Angeles, CA received this year's award for his outstanding athletic achievement. A 1992 Olympic hopeful, Powell long jumped 29 feet 1/4 inches in August 1990 making him the world record holder in the long jump.

The dinner, which was attended by more than 800 guests, attracted many prominent ath-

letes, business leaders, notable politicians and celebrities. Former Atlanta mayor and U.S. congressman, Andrew Young served as keynote speaker for the event. ABC Sports commentator, Jack Whitaker served as MC during the ceremony.

"This is presently the only award of its kind."
