The work shall commence within 30 consecutive calendar days after the effective date of a Notice to Proceed and shall be completed within 45 consecutive calendar days.

Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes, Chapter 338, bidders are hereby notified that the prevailing wage rates established by the Nevada State Labor Commissioner must be paid to all workmen engaged in the performance of any public work construction contracts awarded for the amount of \$100,000.00 or more. Said prevailing wage rates effective October 1, 1991, through September 30, 1992, as issued by the State of Nevada, Office of Labor Commissioner, are included in the Contract Volume.
