## FROM PRISON TO PRISON

Former convict, Sam
Huddleston, will be speaking in
Sunday evening, May 24th at
the Genesis II Christian
Center, where Davy Peoples is
the pastor.

At thirteen, Sam was involved in drugs, alcohol, and crime. At seventeen, he was convicted of murder and sent to prison for life. It was said of Sam that he would not live be twenty-one. But while in prison, the Lord saved him and set him free from sin and from prison.

After prison, San earned a Master's Degree in marriage, family and adolescent counseling, and was subsequently appointed the director of "Match-2" prison ministry in San Quentin, California.

Match-2 is the largest prison ministry of its kind in the nation and Sam is the first ex-felon to
