Nevada State Assemblyman Wendell P. Williams will kick-off his bid for a 4th term in the Nevada Legislature, on Friday, July 3, 1992. Williams who serves as chairman of the state standing legislative committee on education, said that we need to continue to focus on restructuring education in Nevada. This is one of the key reasons that he is seeking re-election. Assemblman Williams has sponsored and passed into law eight (8) bills that are related to public education, including one that recieved national attention, that dealt with restructuring the selection process of the textbooks, based on their conclusion of lessons reflecting the deeds, exploits and culture of all people of color, in the subjects of science, liturature and history. Williams also expressed a desire to expand on legislation that we introduced in 1989 that created Nevada's first contigency plan that dealt with the procedures the state would follow once notification of intent was recieved that a reduction in work force or the closure of the Nevada test site was in effect. When speaking of his upcoming campaign he stated "In the last three sessions, on behalf of the people, I've gotten 25 bills passed into law. I want to expand on a broader agenda for progressive economic and Humanities Realities for all Nevadans". Williams also cited the fact now that State Senator Joe Neal has announced that his upcoming term will be his last, that he plans to expand his political agenda to put in place long range plans for the people of Senate District #4.
