INTEREST RATES REDUCED TO A TWENTY YEAR LOW

A surprisingly weak June Employment Report which included a surge in the jobless rate to 7.8% sent a clear signal that the U.S. economy is still sick and spurred the Federal Reserve to slash its key lending rates.

The Fed recently announced it was cutting the discount rate it charges commercial banks by a half-point to a 29 year low of 3%. The Central Bank followed by cutting the Federal Funds rate, an overnight bank lending rate which is its other key monetary policy lever.

By this time, major commercial banks had already taken their cur and cut their prime lending rate to a 20 year low of 6%. The Prime Rate is the base rate for most borrowing activity by consumers. This rate hits home for all of us.

Lower interest rates are good for the economy overall, and lower rates are a sign that inflation is in check. But lower interest rates also mean lower interest earned on your CD'S and money market accounts and Treasury Bills. According to the bank rate monitor, one year CD's could fall to 3.8% in average vs. 4.02% just a week ago, thus, adjusted for inflation, the riskless investments have no return at all.

Now is the time to seek out better money making alternatives, so that you can take advantage of low inflation and increase your investment returns. You will not get ahead financially without assuming some risk, that risk can be very low and you can earn 3% to 4% more money. How?
