CARSON CITY — Nevada's statewide seasonally adjusted unemployment increased 0.8 percentage points to 6.6 percent in June, Stan Jones, Executive Director of the Nevada Employment Security Department has announced

"Nevada's June unemployment rate reflects the state's continued soft economy. While

Nevada is faring much better than many states, we are not experiencing a robust recovery at this time," Jones said.

He pointed out, on the positive side, initial unemployment insurance claims are down nearly one percent over-the-year, and the average weekly duration of claims has stabilized at 14.6 week — the lowest since the onset of the recession. Jones also noted minimal growth of 10,300 jobs over-the-year.

Jones said the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics reported the nation's seasonally adjusted civilian unemployment rate for June was 7.8 percent, up .3 percentage points over-the-month. And, neighboring California's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was estimated at 9.5 percent, up .8 percentage points during the same time period.

The department's monthly

survey shows that seasonally adjusted unemployment throughout the state's 17 counties ranged from a low of 2.1 percent in Eureka County to a high of 12.4 in Esmeralda County. During June, Las Vegas (Clark County) unemployment was estimated at 7.0 percent, up 0.8 percentage points over-the-month and up 0.7 percentage points when compared to a year ago. Reno's (Washoe County) June jobless rate was estimated at 6.8 percent, up 0.9 percentage points during the 30-day period. In June 1991, Reno's unemployment rate was 5.5 percent.

According to the department's labor economists, retail and wholesale employers (including general merchandise) accounted for an estimated 131,100 jobs, an increase of 2,000 jobs when compared to the same time a year ago. The

mining industry recorded a reported 13,600 jobs during June — 100 fewer jobs than June a year ago. And, employment in manufacturing picked up 200 jobs since June 1991, with 26,300 jobs reported.

The finance, insurance and real estate sector picked up 200 jobs over-the-year with 29,500 jobs reported. And, the transportation and public utilities sector reported no change in the number of jobs since this time a year ago with 33,200 jobs in the sector. Reported employment in federal, state and local government, including teachers, totals 79,400 jobs down 6,900 over-the-month and 800 over-the-year. The decrease of government jobs reflects, for the most part, the end of the school year in Clark County.

The construction industry showed gains with 1,100 more jobs since May.
