Oakey Blvd. on Mondays from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and on Thursdays from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. Other locations are the Las Vegas Library, 833 Las Vegas Blvd. N. (across from Cashman Field) on Wednesday and the Charleston Heights Library, 800 Brush Street (off W. Charles

between Decatur and Jones) on Fridays.

The library locations prepare returns between 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. appointment only. Call 455-1212 for an appointment. Assistants at that number can also provide information on how to obtain lost or misplaced W-2 and 1099 information.

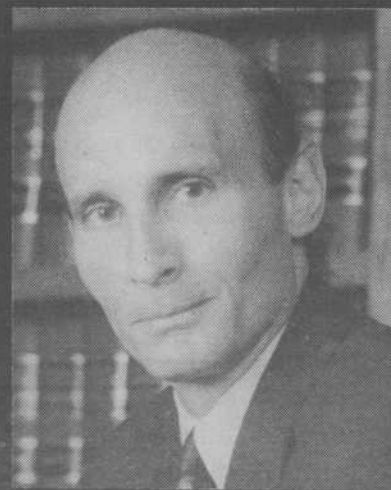
