The Black Professional Males were organized and began operation less than nine months ago, long before the riots in Los Angeles.

We fight the problems in the placed they start, in corporate America.

> Many of the Black Professional Males are employed in the top 100 corporations and have significant knowledge about how these corporations work. Also many of our members are janitors, construction workers, guards, mechanics, and many more occupations. Our theory is that everyone can be a professional male no matter what occupation they may have. Our goal is to address all issues that degrade the character of the Black man. Of special interest is the employment of the Black man, the withholding of contracts from Black men's companies, the denial of loans to the Black man (lending insti-

tutions), and many more real-life complaints and issues that restrict the Blacks from progress. The question...Why is the

organization's only purpose to help Black Men?? Black men are the most talented of all the male species on earth. The simple pursuit of happiness is the strong hold on the Black man. Everyone wants to hold him back because of his inherent talent to succeed at what endeavor he selects. In the three hundred years in America, only some Black men have been given the really true freedom to succeed. Now, taking a scientific approach to this problem, we the Black Professionals have developed a method that is successful, and will greatly improve the Black man's plight on all issues. We are completely dedicated to wage this tooth and nail fight and in simple terms we know we will win. Unfortunately, the Black woman is straddled with inequities that have built up over the years, and isn't aware of what is happening. In some remote cases she enjoys holding back the Black man for the shear pleasure of doing it, and helping the white man succeed at whatever needs to be done. As we win the issues as Black


