

# BONANZA AND LAS VEGAS SQUARE OFF IN DIVISION OPENER

This Friday night, Donnie Davis will lead his Las Vegas Wildcat offensive into Bonanza High School's stadium in hopes of capturing their first Sunset Division victory of the young season.

Las Vegas High boasts the city's second-ranked offensive, averaging 310.5 yards per game with an average of 271 yards coming on the ground.

Davis is averaging 118 ypg., compiling 38 percent of the Wildcats' offense.

Bonanza will try to counter Vegas High's offense with one of the city's worst ranked defensive teams. Coincidentally, Bonanza is tied with the Wildcats, giving up an average of 312 ypg., placing them eleventh and twelfth in the conference. Cimarron-Memorial, who is thirteenth, is at the bottom of the conference.

Unfortunately Bonanza also falls in the bottom half of the

rankings in the offensive category. Averaging 190.1 ypg., the Bengals strength will rely on QB Levi Hancock's arm. Hancock is the second-leading passer in the conference behind Eldorado's Tim Hernandez.

In other games this Friday, Eldog will host Dorsey High School, of California; Chaparral will travel to Western; Cheyenne

will take its second-ranked defense to the Silver Bowl and face Gorman; Clark will welcome Cimarron-Memorial to Barnson Field; Basic will travel to National City, California and display their air raid against Sweetwater High; and the Gators of Green Valley will also cross the border and face Montgomery High in San Diego, California.
