AFRICAN-AMERICAN HISTORY

CONDUCTO

By Gwen Walker In 1941 Dean Dixon became the first African-American, and at 26, the voungest musician ever to conduct the New York Philharmonic Orchestra.

Dixon was born in Manhattan on January 10, 1915 and graduated from Dewitt Clinton



High School in 1932. His parents exposed him to classical music by regularly taking him to Carnegie Hall. Dixon formed his own amateur orchestra at the Harlem YMCA while still in high school.

On the basis of a successful violin audition, he was admitted to the Juilliard Institute of Musical Art, where he received his B.S. in 1936. Three years later he acquired his master's from Columbia.

The Dean Dixon Symphony Society, which he had formed in 1932, began to receive financial support from the Harlem community in 1937, and in 1941, at the request of Eleanor Roosevelt, Dixon gave a concert at the Heckscher Theatre. He was later signed by the musical director of NBC to conduct the networks summer symphony in two concerts. Two month after the NBC concerts he made his debut with the Philhar-
