Recently I had the chance to read excerpts from Nicholas Von Hoffman's new book, Capitalist Fools: the story of American business from Carnegie to Forbes to the Milken Gang, where he claimed that,"too many of our children are being summarily abandoned to the commercial standards and whims of big business by their parents and by the education system that is grossly inadequate, at best" The reality of the matter is that our children are becoming more brand-conscious. Yes, even toddlers have become detached and turned into customers. Yesterday, while walking around the neighborhood, I overheard a young child inform his parents that he was bored, as if it was their job to amuse him around the clock. It just seems that some of our youth, who have never experienced the real ups and downs of life, are growing up with an entertainment-Nintendo world view

Interesting enough, at the same time that this kidnapping of the minds of our children is happening right before our eyes, many local churches are struggling with Sunday School atten-
