AFRICAN-AMERICAN HISTORY CHUCK BERRY

VOCALIST, GUITARIST, COMPOSER

Chuck Berry was born Charles Edward Berry, October 18, 1926 in San Jose, California.

His family moved to St. Louis, Missouri, in the 1930's.

Chuck Berry gained musical experience in school glee-clubs
and church choirs. He was a trained hairdresser and a car
factory worker.

In 1955 he recorded some songs for an audition and traveled North to Chicago to look for successful bluesman Monday Waters.

Monday suggested Berry take the tapes to Chess Records. Leonard Chess was interested in the embryonic version of Maybellene and had the young Berry record a polished version for chess debut; it topped the R&B charts and began a prolific succession of hits like Brown Eyed Handsome Man; Roll Over Beethoven; Sweet Little Sixteen; School Day.

Berrys records are notable for their lyrical content and distinctive guitar style:

On stage, Berry played solo while hopping around in a squatting posture; this came to be described as the "Duck Walk."

His consistency of hit singles resulted in several movie parts:

1. Go Johnny Go; 2. Rock Rock Rock; 3. Film of 1959 Newport Jazz Festival, Jazz on a Summers Day in which he sung Sweet Little Sixteen.

Starting in 1964 Berry had such hits as:

Nadine; 2. Particular Place To Go; 3. You Never Can Tell;
 My Ding A Ling; 5. Reelin And Rocking


