
'Sheet' Pumpkin Pie For A Crowd



A true dessert lover always saves room for dessert, especially during holidays and celebrations when a crowd is the order of the day for most. For many, a crowd means spending long hours in the kitchen. Help is here. This easy version of America's favorite holiday pie turns dessert making for a crowd into a breeze. LIBBY'S Famous Pumpkin Pie for a Crowd is 'sheet' pie with all the flavor, richness and smooth custard texture of the more traditional round pie. To serve, cut into squares and top with your favorite pie topping.

LIBBY'S FAMOUS PUMPKIN PIE FOR A CROWD (Makes 12 to 16 servings)

Pastry for double-crust 9-inch pie 4 eggs, lightly beaten 3 1/4 cups (29-ounce can) LIBBY'S Solid Pack

Pumpkin 1 1/2 cups granulated sugar

1 teaspoon salt

- 2 teaspoons ground cinnamon teaspoon ground ginger
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cloves
- 3 cups (two 12-ounce cans) undiluted CARNATION **Evaporated Milk** Vanilla yogurt or whipped cream for garnish (optional)

Lay two 9-inch pastry rounds into 13 x 9 x 2-inch baking dish, overlapping at center of dish. Trim overhanging dough from 9-inch sides of dish; use trimmings to fill spaces. Trim dough even with edges of dish; press edges all around with tines of fork. In large bowl, combine eggs, pumpkin, sugar, salt, cinnamon, ginger, cloves, and evaporated milk. Pour into pie shell. Bake in preheated 425°F, oven for 15 minutes. Reduce temperature to 350°F. Bake an additional 50 to 60 minutes or until knife inserted near center comes out clean. Cool before cutting. Garnish with dollop of vanilla yogurt or whipped cream, if desired.
