EARLY SPRING REGISTRATION SET FOR DEC. 1-11

Several new functions have been added to the telephone registration system at the Community College of Southern Nevada, making it easier than ever for students to register for classes.

According to Arlie J. Stops, Director of Admissions and Records at CCSN, the new functions include "Shop" which allows and Records, students to search the database for open sections of a course and "Account Balance Inquiry" which will give students a balance of tuition and fees owed.

In addition, telephone registration now allows students to pay for their course with their Visa, Mastercard, Discover, Carte Blanche or Diner's Club credit cards.

Early Telephone registration for currently enrolled students at The Community College of Southern Nevada will begin Tuesday, December 1 and run through Friday, December 11 at all three campuses. Currently

enrolled students whose last name begins with the letters G-L can register December, 1; M-O, December 2; P-R, December 3, and A-F, December 4.

Students may access the telephone registration system from 8 a.m. - 7 p.m. Monday through Friday by dialing 643-7026. Telephone registration

for all students will take place from Monday, December 14 through Friday, January 8 from 8 a.m. - 7 p.m. at all campuses. Walk-in registration for new students will also take place at those times. Mail-in registration runs from Monday, December 14 until Monday, January 4.

Stops encourages students to use the college's phone registration system. "It's very easy to register by phone," Stops said. "All you need is a touch-tone phone and a few minutes of time."

CCSN continues to have record enrollments with figures for the Fall semester up 19 percent over the same time last year. Spring class schedules will be mailed to most residents in the Las Vegas valley.

Those who did not receive a schedule may pick one up at anY of the CCSN's three campuses.
