He has mild, non-degenerative Cerebral Palsy affecting his lower extremities. However, it is not noticeable and he rides his tricycle, plays on a swing and runs. Physical therapy by the foster parent in his home has helped a great deal. He has

chronic digestive system problems since birth due to esophageal reflex and problems with diarrhea. He has undergone surgery for these problems and cannot have anything with a casing on it.

Joshua has developed in all areas within normal limits. He talks a lot and loves to play games and color.

Joshua needs a two-parent African-American home where he will receive lots of attention and especially love.
