A few pastors and ministers in Indianapolis, IN, have been sharing with each other, their concerns about the plight and prognoses of African-American males, in particular, and African-Americans, as a whole. Prayer for the week of February 14-20, 1993.

They are asking individuals, pastors, ministers alliances, congregations and denominations throughout the USA to join in this National Call to African-American Men to Prayer. They are asking that each pastor and local congregation

will focus its prayer concern on the plight of African-Americans in general and African-American men in particular. Our prayer focus should be in keeping with the words of Rev. Jesse Jackson, when he said, "Nobody can save us from us, but us." In that vein, our prayer should be fourfold:

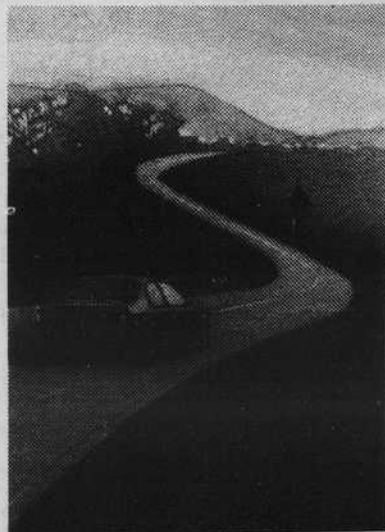
1. Repentance for having internalized and actualized Euro-America's stereo-typical and degrading assessment of us, as a people, rather than holding fast to our own heritage, history and values.

4. Seek God's directions and vision for our freedom from racist oppression and the rebuilding of our families, communities and churches.
