RELIGIOUS LEADERS DECRY ANTI-ABORTION CLINIC VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN & DOCTORS

According to Ann Thompson Cook, Executive Director of the Religious Coalition for Abortion Rights, "The Supreme Court's unfortunate ruling recently underscores that women and medical personnel will continue to be subjected to the whims of terrorists until Congress acts boldly to ensure women's safe access to health care services."

Rev. Elenora Giddings Ivory, RCAR Vice President and member of RCAR's Women of Color Partnership, stated, "I am outraged by the Court's failure to recognize that a law that offers protection from mob violence to one group — such as African American children seeking an education — would not also apply equally to another group — namely, our women seeking medical services."

Signing the following statement are more than 100 clergy and religious leaders affiliated with the United Methodist Church, the Presbyterian Church (USA), The American and Southern Baptist Churches, Reform and Reconstructionist Judaism, and Episcopal Church, the Lutheran Church, Christ Church (Disciples of Christ), the United Church of Christ, the American Ethical Un-

ion, and the Unitarian Universalist Association:

"We are pro-choice clergy religious leaders. Our support for abortion rights is deeply rooted in our religious beliefs, and, like all freedom-loving people, we do not want another minister or another church telling us what to believe. The Religious Right is wrong...women can, and do, morally choose abortion.

"As pro-choice clergy and religious leaders, we:
• pray for the doctors and their families here and across the country who daily face the threat of intimidation, public harassment, property damage, and physical violence.

• Offer our prayers for women who decide abortion is the right choice in their unique situation yet are frequently subjected to acts of violence and intimidation.

• Support the non-violent efforts of the people who are prepared to defend clinics against acts of violence."

On January 22-23, clergy and religious leaders from these denominations and others will demonstrate their support for women and medical personnel in front of clinics throughout the Washington, D.C. area.
