The popularity of the show in Europe and Asia has made Greg an instantly recognizable industry celebrity all over the world. In addition to his weekly role on "Baywatch," he's had recurring roles on "Civil Wars" and "Hunter," two other popular television series. Additionally, he has guest starred on a number of popular primetime television shows such as "Roc," and "Fresh Prince of Bel-Air;" also the acclaimed Movie of the Week "Howard Beach."

His role in "The Meeting" also contributed to Greg becoming a producer and forming Legacy, a touring company Greg has played key roles in he formed with two associates

to develop and produce small ensemble historical theatre.

He has been referred to as the 'total thespian' and his outstanding multi-talents are evidence in his one man show "The Life And Times Of Deacon A. L. Wiley," a turn of the century epic he wrote under his pseudonym, G. Travis Williams. The piece was filmed as a Public Service Television Special in January

1992, and garnered him a coveted television Ace Award.

He was declared a national

hero during the Los Angeles civil unrest last April when he risked his life to save Takao Hirato, a Japanese American who had become the victim of an angry mob. This personal harrowing experience led to him writing the manuscript "A gathering of Heros." The book is scheduled to be released this summer. It is Greg's hopes that his book will become the vehicle that will propel the reader toward important and uplifting discoveries about personal healing, social solutions, and individual responsibility. His book reveals, up close, the beast of intolerance that would destroy the hatred and the one who hates. Since his display of courage in the Los Angeles riots he's been asked to become the First African-American "Celebrity Spokesperson" for the Boy Scouts of America. This was an offer he couldn't refuse, and the ceremony to install him in this coveted role will take place
