House's 11year-old daughter Tiffany usually is one of the "pilots" in the snowbox, "and then she picks a friend from school," explains House.

The method in which the winners are determined comes after each entrant individually glides down the course so that judges can give points for speed and creativity. There are first place prizes for both speed and creativity, as well as second and third. There are also awards given to those entrants that collect the most money to be donated to the YMCA.

"Mr. House" and Co. have placed five times in the last three years, in all three categories at least once.
