

Contestants are reminded to include their name, address and telephone number. The winner will be notified by March 31st.

In addition to appearing on the front cover of the souvenir magazine for the conference, the winning entry will be placed on display during the conference and the artist will be acknowledged at the NABJ gala "Scholarship Awards Banquets" at Bally's Casino Resort on Saturday, April 24th — also open to the general public.
