FOLLOW "THE LEADER"

A while back, in mid-January, I tried to contact Reverend George H. Clements, an African-American priest of the Roman Catholic Church, and a role model who's now become friend. It was 'Advent' for Armageddon at my job, and I needed, not just spiritual direction, but the REAL deal. Curses! A call to the 'windy' city where he'd been for more than three decades, and the place where his legend was born, revealed he was now pastor to a flock in a new parish, which was in...the Bahamas!

Weeks later, sitting and perusing the Sentinel-Voice and telling sad stories of bad luck to the brothers at Native Son, I found myself struggling to interpret, from a blur, on page 13 of the February fourth edition, in the Religion section, these words:

Father George Clements is coming to St. James Catholic Church in order to do revival on February 8, 9, and 10th."

I blinked, and I was a kid again... What no hosanna?"

Rev. Clements was in Cicero when it was less suburb than war zone, and which, with Selma, helped lead to passage of the Civil Rights Act of 1964... oh yes. Father ducked bricks and bottles with Dr. King. And he carried the standard for black Catholics, into battles with the Archdiocese of Chicago; John Cardinal Cody and his bishops, monsignors, priests, nuns and religious brothers, pillars of the parishes and rank-and-file Catholics, most white, some black. Today he is lionized by many black Catholic baby boomers and was, for me, the Malcolm X of Black Catholicism in Chicago, as was Father Lawrence Lucas (whose book revived me), a role model for boys who grew up in New York.

In 1968, before Dr. King's impending martyrdom, Father Clements was perceived in the diocese as too "militant," a term which struck terror in the clergy and gave the Cardinal indigestion. "Impossible to live with," he was described by elite clerics at middle-class, South Side, black, St. Dorothy's Parish. To no (See Follow the Leader, Page 18)
