## A SENTINEL-VOICE EXCLUSIVE INTERVIEW

The following is a "Sentinel-Voice" exclusive interview with Cassuandra Williams, Property Administrator of Carey Arms Apartments. Ms. Williams concludes our discussion with talking candidly about challenges that she faced when she first took over the management duties of the complex and how she overcame them and she offers some of the optimistic approaches that she intends to execute if she is victorious in her mayoral bid. If elected, she would be both the first female mayor in the that city's history, as will as the the first African-American to hold that office.

MS. WILLIAMS: Our management company spent over \$250,000.00 just last year alone in taking care of the plumbing here. We're refurbishing the roofs. The landscaping, the trees; I mean, just making it visible. Now that we are getting in funds we can do more things. We're going to be putting playground equipment up.

Prior to the riots, we had a recreation room. We lost that after the fire. So now, with that room reconstructed, we will be able to have a place where the children can come and study and do homework. I stress academics, I'm just very strong on academics. I know some of the youth are more interested in a play area, swings, a basketball court, and things such as those, but my personal interest is on the academic level.

There has been so many improvements. For the first time in the history of Carey Arms, we had a talent show last year. We had over one hundred participants and over 1100 people, with no incidents! No stabbings, no shootings, no fights! From two o'clock until six o'clock we had this type of activity.

But of course, that didn't make the newspapers because that was too positive! We held that talent show in September 5th last year, it was on a Saturday. Incidentally, we have plans

because that was so successful.

In regards to your previous question, about approaching the Mayor or the City Councilmen about the problems that I see facing the citizens of North Las Vegas, just attend a regular City Council meeting and you'll notice that whenever there is a mention about the issues facing the residents of the Westside or the concerns of North Las Vegas, those issues seem to be pushed under-the-cover, and I got the impression, "Oh those people over there, let them continue to do whatever they are going to do.

We're going to pay attention to them now because there was a riot." But prior to that, there was very little mention about the concerns of the residents. Now, I'm not saying that we should start another riot, or we should go and beat down the Mayor's door or go to his home, make threats and call him "you-so-andso-and-so.'

I'm saying that we should

approach the problem intelligently and say to him that we should have neighborhood "affordable housing." There is just too much acreage over here for us to have three or more project areas and not have low-income residential "affordable housing," especially when there are millions of dollars available.

But do we have any available in North Las Vegas? No! There is no "affordable housing" over here. We have low income projects. We have Carey Arms

Apartments, we have Herbert Gerson down the street. But those needs have not been addressed. So I would propose that we start at the local level. Let's start locally with the residents, then the City Council, then with the Mayor's office, then let us sponsor legislation to initiate what we're saying. I think that the City Council should have responded to the needs of the residents before the riots. Even though I haven't been a resident here for a long time, I believe that some changes should have occurred before the riots. One does not have to have a Ph.d to see what is going on in the community. I believe that as an

African American woman, that I should do whatever I can to bring these issues forward. Even If I don't win, at least they will say that "She tried!" This lady wants to do something and Carey Arms

# NORTH LAS VEGAS NHS TO SPONSOR A RESIDENTS' VISION SETTING MEET TO REVITALIZE A NLV NEIGHBORHOODS

The North Las Vegas Neighborhood Housing Services, Inc. will sponsor the first vision setting meeting for one of the targeted neighborhoods that the NHS has designated to receive rehabilitation support. This meeting will be held on Saturday, March 20 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Wesley United Methodist Church at 2727 Civic Center Drive in North Las Vegas, and will be specifically for the purpose of giving the residents an opportunity to voice their concerns.

"The vision setting is done by the residents, for the residents and it will be their visions of what they would like their neighborhood to be. Individual and collective voices will be heard and a course of action will be set to begin the revitalizing process," said Rene' Merlau-Shreder, Executive Director of the NLV NHS.

A residents-based organization, North Las Vegas Neighborhood Housing Services, Inc. Is a partnership between local government, business, and residents and is dedicated to revitalizing neighborhoods. "The support and enthusiasm is there, now we will proceed with the vision setting and develop workable solutions to help the neighborhood," said Merlau-Shreder. "Together, as a team, this partnership has the opportunity to make some major neighborhood improvements and with the direction of the residents, programs and projects will be structured that are best suited to their

Low cost loan programs, structure rehab, and vacant property infill are just some of the areas that the NLV NHS will concentrate in. Other programs like the Homebuyers Club will be organized to encourage, and

provide counseling and support, on home ownership.

Although the NHS will concentrate efforts in the two targeted neighborhoods, many programs and workshops will be provided for all North Las Vegas Residents
