I'm not going around waving a "magic ward" making things happen. If you go around and talk to the residents they will probably say, "Now, Ms. Williams will fuss, but she cares."

ABDULLAH: So the standards have substantially changed since you have been managing the properties?

MS. WILLIAMS: Our standards are extremely high here. Our screening process for example, takes over two months. Carey Arms used to have a reputation that if you need a place to stay, go to Carey Arms. That's just not the case anymore.

ABDULLAH: Have there been a decrease in the crime on the property since you have taken over? I noticed that before our interview a uniformed officer


