GOD HELPS (LIBERATE) THOSE WHO HELP THEMSELVES By Al Triche

Nearly sixteen-hundred years ago an African bishop, one of Christianity's greatest intellects said, "I believe, and therefore I speak out." Showing the same disarming simplicity as did Descartes ("Cogito ergo sum"), St. Augustine was no less profound with those words from his classic, Confessions. He has given me the rationale for what has become a layman's fascination (if not obsession) with the concept of liberation theology.

The practice of religion, certainly for the true Christian, is inextricably linked to an effort to achieve true freedom for the oppressed in this world. Long before Christ arrived scripture relates how the Almighty reminded Moses (Ex. 19:4-5) that he delivered the Hebrews from their Egyptian slavemasters, and implied that if that newly liberated people remained faithful to Him they would have His protection. Elsewhere in the Old Testament the famous 23rd Psalm is preceded by the 10th, a prayer for help against oppressors. Later, in the New Testament, Jesus essentially kicks-off His ministry by announcing that part of His mission was "... to proclaim liberty to captives..." (Lk. 4:18). Liberation is not simply part of the "Good News," it is the essence of the Gospel, the basic fabric of the salvation tapestry.

Contrary to an all-too-popular notion, God is not color blind, certainly not in a racist society. Just as Yahweh chose a side, so too did Jesus align Himself with the poor and oppressed. Today as well, Divine providence stands ready to act on behalf of the downtrodden, making the fight for liberation, as Torres puts it, "a Christian, a priestly struggle.

In its worst form, the white-American version of theology sanctioned genocide of indigenous people and enslavement of blacks. Small wonder that African-American Muslims look askance at those among us who cling still to that perverted Anglo model of Christianity. Liberation theology demands that the pristine tenants of Jesus coexist with ethnocentricity of the oppressed, and in U.S. society people are oppressed because they are black

The social focus of the African American Christian should be clear. It is the common objective of Black Islam and Black Christendom in American...liberation in the present time. Between these two powerful forces dialogue and coalition are long overdue, while preoccupation with theoretical differences due to theology are secondary and counter-productive to our goal of real freedom for all Black Americans. To be sure, we must put God first, but that needn't be cause for discord. We can worship apart while fighting for liberation together. This I believe, and therefore I speak
