DESCRIPTION OF CONTRACT

The Work of this Contract is located at McCarran International Airport, Las Vegas, and comprises a two level steel structure with GFRC curtain walls, four passenger boarding gates with holding areas and related facilities. The building will be connected to the existing Main Terminal and "C" Satellite Terminal Buildings by elevated concourse and moving walkways which are also a part of this Contract. The project includes all architectural, structural, mechanical and electrical work required to construct a complete and functional satellite terminal building.
