NORTH LAS VEGAS VOTERS TO DECIDE FATE OF THE \$10 MILLION STREET IMPROVEMENT BOND

North Las Vegas voters will decide on June 8 whether to approve insurance of up to \$10 million in general obligation bonds to finance the improvement of many of the community's older streets.

According to Mayor James K. Seastrand, "the \$10 million in bonds, if approved by voters, will be sold over a four to six year period and will not cause an increase in property taxes."

The assessed valuation of real property in North Las Vegas has been increasing markedly. largely due to new residential construction. The increased valuation provides debt service capacity without increasing
