He went on to say that reasons for the payment errors range from claimants fraud- to claimants failing to conduct the required work search; claiming benefits in a week in which the claimant actually worked; and employee/employer disputes. Another factor was a nearly tripled workload for the UI division with the handling of 22,390 additional claims generated by the Federal Emergency Unemployment Compensation Act.

The year-long audit is a state/federal cooperative effort designed and monitored by the U.S. Department of Labor, and conducted by the Nevada Employment Security Department's Quality Control division, as a method to identify UI payment errors and their cause; to find solutions to payment problems; improve accuracy of benefit to clients; and control fraud in the unemployment insurance system.
