"Writing love songs seems to be my strong point and, yes, the songs on SOUL TALKIN' are personal," Brenda smiles. "They're all reflections of experiences I've had or want to have. I make no apologies for being an incurable romantic...and since I happen to believe that in the 90's romance is dying, I have to keep writing songs about love as my way of keeping romance alive!"

For those in love or those who still yearn for the experience, BRENDA RUSSELL offers a whole range of satisfying music, from the perkiness of tunes like "Got To Love" and the title track, to memorable songs like "Matters Of The Heart" and the poignant, poetic "Who Are You" (penned by Bill Cantos), the only non-original Russell composition on the album.

"My approach to making those records was to pick the best songs, whether they were old or new,' she says. "I wrote "No Time For Time" about ten years ago and Herb Albert recorded it for one of his albums in 1986. "In Over My Heart" was finished last year. "Soul Talkin" was recorded by Chaka Khan a few years ago, while "The Universe Is Calling" (written with Brazilian music star Ivan Lins) is new. I feel that if a song works, it doesn't matter if you wrote it yesterday or five years ago."

Her hands-on work <u>SOUL TALKIN'</u> comes as a natural progression for BRENDA RUSSELL, whose early exposure to music came via her father, a professional singer and drummer, and her mother, a singer-songwriter in her own right. After her family moved to Canada when she

was in her early teens, Brenda began honing her own musical skills, singing with local groups and joining the cast of the musical, Hair. It was during this time that she met and eventually married Brian Russell. The duo moved to Los Angeles in the mid-70's, and Brenda began doing session work with the likes of Barbara Streisand, Bette Midler, Cher, and Elton John.
