## MILLER APPOINTS TOP NEVADA EXECUTIVES TO HELP REFORM SIIS

Governor Bob Miller announced that five executives from some of the state's most successful businesses will be on loan to the State Industrial Insurance System for up to a year to help implement workers' compensation reforms recently signed into law.

The five executives will work as assigned by the governor and the SIIS general manager on the highest priority projects, including areas such as health care and rehabilitation.

While these executives will work for the state, their salaries and benefits will continue to be paid by their companies. The state will reimburse them for travel and office expenses.

"These companies are making a tremendous sacrifice, but they realize we're in an emergency," Miller said. "These individuals are truly some of the best and brightest Nevada has to offer."

The loaned executives are: Bob Ostrovsky, corporate vice president of Human Resources for Bally's; Donna Pierce, insurance administrator for Southwest Gas; director of personnel and insurance administration for John Ascuaga's Nugget; David Olson, vice president and general counsel for Citibank (Nevada) N.A.; and Patricia Becker, senior vice president and general counsel for the Harrah's Corp.

Bob Ostrovsky, Larry Harvey and Donna Pierce have extensive experience in admini-

stering their businesses' self-insured workers' compensation programs. "They have proven records of hiring and operating high-quality health systems for employees," Miller said.

Along with his responsibilities at Bally's, Ostrovsky is a former president of the Self-Insured Employers Association. Harvey has previously been a regional manager for a northern Nevada health maintenance organization and worked for Mutual of Omaha and Pierce is on the Nevada Self-Insurers Association's board of directors.

Olson and Becker have significant experience setting up and working for a major corporation's management team, Miller said.

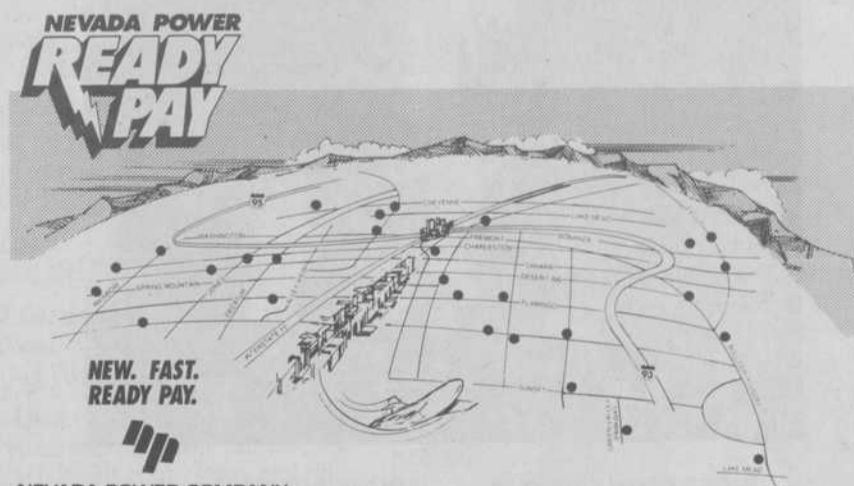
