HOW-TO BOOK WILL HELP CHURCH

GROUPS ADDRESS THE HOUSING CRISIS WORLD VISION AFFORDABLE HOUSING GUIDE FOR CHURCHES

World Vision has published a one-of-a-kind book that gives pastors and lay leaders the step-by-step information they need to produce housing for low-income families in their communities.

"Rebuilding Our Communities: How Churches Can Provide, Support, and Finance Quality Housing for Low-Income Families," (280 pages) describes 25 different housing strategies. Most are easy to start and easy to run, giving inexperienced churches the know-how to put a new project into action. Other strategies help more experienced groups understand how to move to the next level of accomplishment.

"There are hundreds of thousands of low-income families who cannot afford decent housing in America today," said Bob Mitchell, Vice-President of U.S. Programs. "The downturn of the economy is making affordable housing an even more urgent issue in our society, and the federal budget is inadequate to deal with these needs. Churches in every community in our nation have the power and responsibility to respond, and many have already done so by using these tried and true methods," Mitchell added.

Each section of "Rebuilding Our Communities" outlines how to plan, pay for, staff and operate a housing program. Real-life case examples from urban and rural churches around the country illustrate each strategy and show how church members have responded effectively to the needs of the poor around them.

"This book provides significant programs that even churches with very limited resources and experience can do," commented Anne Kelly, who manages World Vision's U.S. Programs division and oversaw the book's research and editing.

"Rebuilding Our Communities" is the centerpiece of World Vision's community development effort, the National Urban and Rural Ministries Program. Supported by grants from the Pew Charitable Trusts, the program funds church-based housing, employment and economic development programs in six areas of the country.
