MORE THAN 50,000 VISITORS PLAN TO SAMPLE THE BIG APPLE

New York, N.Y. - The National Baptist Convention USA, Inc. (NBC, USA) will hold it's 1993 session in New York City. September 6th - 12th. It will be held in Madison Square Garden, the N.Y. Hilton Hotel, the Sheraton, N.Y. and the Ramada Hotels. There are also 21 participating hotels through the New York Convention and Visitors Bureau. This year's Convention will bring a message of hope and unity to the Big Apple with the theme "The Gospel of Jesus For These Troubled Times."

Local Baptist Host Pastors are busy preparing for the Convention, which is expected to attract more than 50,000 visitors and generate nearly 40 million dollars in economic activity in New York.

The NBC, USA - the largest African-American religious organization in the world - has 8.5 million members and 26,000 affiliated churches throughout the United States. There are 600 affiliated churches and nearly1 million members in the Greater N.Y. area.

It has been almost 60 years since the Convention last met in New York City in 1935. General Secretary W. Franklyn Richardson is the Chief Operating Officer. "The personal interest that Mayor Dinkins has taken in facilitating our convention has gone a long way in our willingness to make New York the 1993 Convention site," he said.

The NBC, USA held it's 1992 Annual Convention in Atlanta, Georgia and it's 1991 Convention in Washington, D.C.

The week-long Convention will include an agenda that meets the spiritual needs of local attendees, as well as an opportunity to show a United Christian witness to the local community. Local churches have extended an open invitation for visitors to
