with violence on a daily basis. There seem to be no end to the blood shed and innocent victims. Everyday, new reports of violence flood in like a unsuspected hurricane. Grandmothers to priests are working night and day to end this dilemma.

Two more have joined the fight against violence: Duane, 8 and Dion, 4, a.k.a. Double Trouble. Their educational rap song, "Stop The Violence," is their contribution to this problem. You might wonder what an eight and four year old could do to better things. The fact is we could learn a lot from Double Trouble. They recently fled from a violent abuser along with their mother and older sister.

The family suffered emotional as well as physical setbacks from their abuser. But enough was enough and they found themselves on the run. It took a lot of courage for the family to leave and begin to rebuild their lives and so far they're taking one day at a time.

"Violence would stop if people stopped shooting and hurting each other," said Duane. Dion agreed, and believes that one day violence will stop. It's unfortunate that these youngsters have firsthand knowledge of violence. However, from their efforts, thousands have been exposed to their trials and

Shanelle, the boys' mother, along with their sister Monique, 14, help to coordinate the wardrobe, choreography and appearances. They have been a part of the group since the beginning. They don't mind helping out because Duane and Dion are telling a story they once lived.
