As I mentioned, the fact that a child goes to bed at night hungry is societal violence; the fact that an African American female attorney makes 60% to 65% of what her white male counterpart makes is societal violence, the fact that an African physician will earn less than 70% of what his white counterpart makes is societal violence; the fact that African controlled hospitals are closing at an astronomical rate in this country and have been doing so for the last 30 years is societal violence; the fact that African physicians are being excluded from Managed Care organizations, excluded from HMO's such as HPN, Family Health Plan etc., is a societal violence; because the people who have historically cared for Africans have been Africans, not Europeans. Until we expand the scope of what we talk about in terms of societal violence, societal violence will continue because the youth will not walk gladly to the ovens.
