interests, as well as the challenges of the legislative process.

"My job is to help keep the department moving, worry about the secretary's departmental interests and shepherd various issues until it is time for the secretary to take over and make the necessary decision."

"In some matters I may be delegated to handle them completely."

Although he and his wife Angel LaVerne had a comfortable situation, good friends and a hospitable community in Rochester, Broadnax says she agreed with him that moving to Washington for the HHS job "would be a great opportunity to help the Secretary and the president to bring about meaningful change for the country."

He has known Secretary Shalala since 1972 when he was studying for his doctorate degree at the Maxwell School of Citizenship and Public Affairs at Syracuse University.

Secretary Shalala had received her doctorate from the Maxwell School and was a frequent visitor and booster.

While HHS will continue working with groups it has traditionally assisted, Broadnax expects that "budget constraints will prevent our increasing support in some areas. We may have to decrease some areas in order to increase others."

"All programs will come under scrutiny. Ways to better target our resources will increasingly be the challenge. There may be some things we would like to do that we aren't doing now."

Broadnax comes from Star City, Ark., a small town near Pine Bluff. He received his bachelor's degree from Washburn University of Topeka in 1967; his M.P.A. from Kansas University in 1969, and Ph.D. from the Maxwell School at Syracuse University in 1975.

Broadnax has served as a consultant to national and state agencies on organization, management development and budget and finance. He has served on the faculties of the John F. Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University and the Federal Executive Institute.

He previously worked as a principal deputy assistant secretary in the department and was aboard in 1980 then the Department of Health, Education and Welfare became HHS. He has
