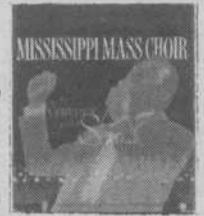

Jeanette Davis was born October 12, 1937 in Starkville, Mississippi to Eckford and Gertha Alexander.

She moved to Colorado Springs, Colorado, with her family in 1942. She graduated from Colorado Springs, under the leadership of Rev. T.J. Marigna.

In 1960, she was united in holy matrimony to Willie Davis in Denver, Colorado. To this union they were blessed with three children: Daryl, Lisa and Dawn Antoinette, all presently residing in Las Vegas. Her husband was called to the gospel ministry in 1967.

She was faithful in her service to the Lord until failing health became evident that her service had to be minimized.

Willie Davis; three children: Daryl, Lisa and Dawn Antoinette; one daughter-in-law, Vanessa; three grandchildren: Kellon and Terron Davis and DeWayne Fisher. She also leaves her mother: Gertha Williams of Colorado Springs, Colorado; one sister: Frances Holmes; one brother: Charles Alexander, one brother-in-law, Willie Holmes, and one sister-in-law, Sandy Alexander — all of Widefield, Colorado; and one aunt and uncle: Jack and Ludie Alexander of Seattle, Washington, and one goddaughter, Janis Clardy of Las Vegas.
