

COUNTY RECEIVES GRANT TO AID EMERGENCY FOOD AND SHELTER PROGRAMS

Under Phase XII of the National Emergency Food and Shelter Program, Clark County has been selected to receive \$441,878 in grant money to help supplement area emergency food and shelter programs. Applications to receive monies from this grant are currently being accepted by the local Emergency Food and Shelter Board (EFS). Any Clark County non-profit agency providing emergency food and shelter is invited to make application by Dec. 15, 1993.

The local EFS board, made up of local agencies representing all facets of emergency food and shelter services, will determine how Clark County funds will be distributed.

Under the terms of the grant, local government and/or private voluntary organizations selected to receive funding must qualify and adhere to the following: 1. be non-profit, 2. have a standard accounting system in place and conduct an annual audit, 3. practice nondiscrimination, 4. have demonstrated the capability to deliver food and/or shelter programs, and 5. if they are a private voluntary organization, they must have a voluntary board of directors.

The award to Clark County was made by a national board that is chaired by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and consists of representatives from the Salvation Army, American Red Cross, Council of Jewish Federations, Catholic Charities USA,

National Council of the Churches of Christ in the USA, and the United Way of America. On a local level, United Way provides the administrative staff for the management of the grant, as well as

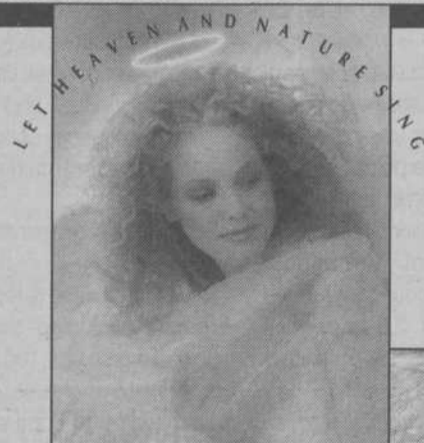
