
should do what is required to qualify before you go knocking.

Don't expect a handout. Too often, ethnic business owners assume that they are entitled to be granted a contract simply because of their ethnicity. They make race the issue, rather than their capability to deliver the goods or services needed. That's not the name of the game. The name of the game is free enterprise ... competing to achieve the desired goal. On the other hand, where it becomes apparent that discrimination exists, don't hesitate to call it that and use the proper steps to squelch that vile practice as well as it's practitioners. Where race is the main focus (whether it's on the side of the corporate or agency buyer, or the supplier) the free enterprise process will more than likely be undermined. It's important for agents to know that you are an ethnic supplier, but don't make that your primary condition for doing business.
