The white man had forgotten the leap years. With a formal education Fuller would probably have been another Newton. He died Dec. 29, 1790 at age 80.

Louisiana had three African American Lieut. Governors: Oscar J. Dunn, C.C. Antoine, and PBS Pinchback, who later became Governor. South Carolina had two: Almzo J. Kansler and Richard Gleaves. Mississippi had one: Alexander Davis
