

FREE TAX ASSISTANCE AT LAS VEGAS-CLARK COUNTY LIBRARIES

Beat the April 15 income tax deadline and prepare income tax returns with help from the volunteers of the library district's tax resource centers. Pick up tax forms, printed instructions, additional tax information and reference materials for 1992-'93 taxes at all branch libraries through April 15.

Representatives from the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program will answer questions for taxpayers of all ages. The Tax Counseling for the Elderly (TCE) and American Association of Retired Persons (AARP) programs help seniors.

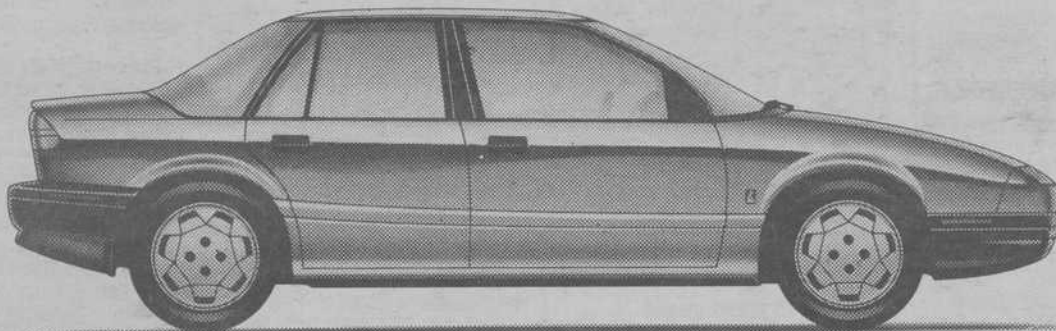

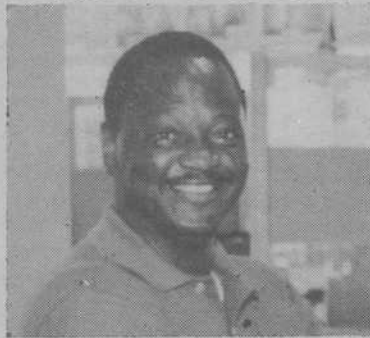

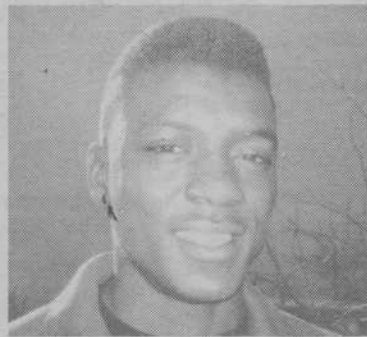

AFRICAN-AMERICAN HISTORY HELEN AND JIM ANDERSON

Helen Anderson Toland is a speech therapist who came to Las Vegas from Los Angeles in 1964 with her husband Jim Anderson.

She became the second Black principal in Las Vegas, heading Kit Carson Sixth Grade Center from 1965 to 1973. Since 1979 she has also been a leader in numerous civil rights efforts.

Jim Anderson was an official of a railroad union in Los Angeles before moving to Southern Nevada. Because of his work as chair of the NAACP Labor and Industry Committee in Las Vegas, he was appointed as the first Executive Director of the Nevada Equal Rights Commission in 1965. His premature death in 1972 shortened a distinguished career as a dedicated exponent of equal employment policies.



Mrs. Toland now travels extensively, including to the motherland and enjoys her retirement.

She is an Honorary member of the Future Walker African-American Museum & Research Center.
