WSGA & AMERICAN GOLF CORPORATION JUNIOR GOLF PROGRAM IN FULL SWING...

The joint venture program that we spoke of weeks ago, whereby the American Golf joined forces with the Southern Area Junior Golf Program of Western States Golf Association (WSGA), to equip and assist in the training of inner city minority youngsters interested in the game of golf is currently in full swing in the inner city communities of Los Angeles.

The program officially kicked off, March 19th, and the tumout of youngsters along with their parents, interested in learning and being trained with professional assistance was overwhelming. Whereas the original program called for four training sites to handle training classes for youngsters desiring to learn more about golf, the overwhelming tumout of youngsters for the program has brought a need for a 5th site to accommodate all the interested youngsters. The additional site to teach and train the youngsters is currently being established.

In addition to teaching and training youngsters, the program also involves their parents and other adults willing to volunteer their time to assist. In this category, American Golf Corporation and WSGA's Southern Area Junior Golf Program have instituted a training program that trains and qualifies the parents and adult volunteers to assist the training of youngsters as coaches who work along with the assigned teaching professionals provided by American Golf Corporation.

Todate, close to 100 complete sets of golf clubs have also been provided by American Golf Corporation to be used by youngsters whose parents can't afford to purchase golf clubs for their children. Free practice balls are also provided for the aspiring junior golfers at the driving ranges of the various training sites involved in the program. Additionally, all youngsters en-

rolled in the program are issued non-transferable identity cards which will allow them to play a round of golf at any American Golf Corporation Golf Course for \$1.00, if they are capable of playing a round without adult
