From his soft serenades to his popular soul tracks, Little Stevie Wonder's musical passion exploded onto the Detroit scene when Ronnie White of the Miracles introduced the singer to Berry Gordy of Motown Records in 1961. Wonder, who is blind since birth, never looked upon his blindness as a handicap. His musical inspiration has been felt around the world, and his prestigious honor — the annual "Award of Merit" in recognition of Wonder's many decades of timeless music.

In the early sixties, Wonder released such classics as "My Cherie Amour," "For Once in My Life," "Uptight, Everything is Alright." Upon turning 21, Wonder decided to take control of his music and proceeded to engineer three "Albums of the Year" including 1970's signature album "Songs in the Key of Life" which featured his hits "Isn't She Lovely" and "Sir Duke." In 1982, Wonder released the song "I Just Called to Say I Love You."

Wonder's political awareness was best exemplified by his contribution to making Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s Birthday a national holiday. He publicized the need for such by helping organize two consecutive marches in Washington, D.C., and is one of the world's most vocal opponents against Apartheid.

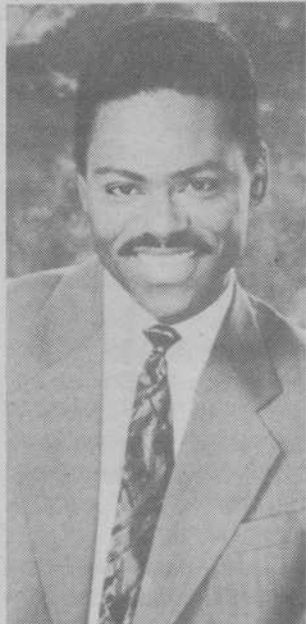
