This film is rated R.

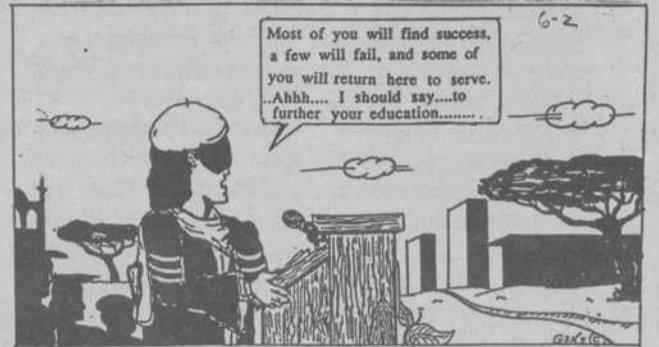
