BAHA'IS PROCLAIM RACE UNITY DAY

The Baha'is of Southern Nevada join with Baha'is in more than 8000 localities throughout the U.S. to celebrate the 37th annual observance of Race Unity Day, Sunday, June 12.

The purpose of this day is to focus attention on what Baha'is regard as the most challenging and vital issue confronting Americans today - racial prejudice.

The Southern Nevada Baha'i Community will observe this day by sponsoring a public meeting at the Baha'i Institute, 1202 S. Martin Luther King Blvd. on Sunday, June 12, at 11:00 a.m.

In the 1860's, during the same years Americans were struggling with the issues of slavery and emancipation, Baha'U'llah, the Prophet-Founder of the Baha'i Faith, reaffirmed the essential unity of mankind, and made the elimination of prejudice the central point of His teachings. He maintained that the greatest challenge of the age is recognizing the oneness of mankind. Over one hundred years ago, Baha'U'llah pointed out that: "The earth is but one country and mankind its citizens."

The Baha'i Faith originated in Iran in the last century. It embraces people from more than 2,100 ethnic, racial and tribal groups and according to the 1992 Encyclopedia Britannica is the second most global religion in the world.
