"These were considered personal loans." The state of Nevada disagreed. He received a call from the Securities Division of the State Attorney General's office which informed him he had been accused of selling securities without a license.

In the original complaint, the state emphatically requested felony charges, yet downgraded all charges to misdemeanor convictions during a subsequent plea bargain. Thomas refused the plea bargain citing discontent with the original charges which he called merely a fabricated attempt to discredit him. "They are either going to give
