Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. as the northern coordinator for the Southern Christian Leadership Conference. She was appointed by President Gerald Ford to the Bicentennial Commission and by President Jimmy Carter to the National Commission on the Observance of International Women's Year.

As an author, Dr. Angelou has 10 published best sellers including "I Know Why the Caged Bird Sings," "All God's Children Need Traveling Shoes," and "And Still I Rise." Her most current work is entitled "I Shall Not Be Moved."

She has made hundreds of television appearances on network and local talk shows and has served as author and executive producer of a five-part mini-series "Three Way Choice" of full-length films including a PBS series entitled "Afro-American in the Arts" for which she received the coveted Golden Eagle Award.

Mrs. Rupert Richardson, President, NAACP National Board of Directors commented: "Dr. Angelou is a woman of character and strength and through her writings she exemplifies womanhood. The NAACP is proud to honor Dr. Angelou for her outstanding contributions to society."

As the 79th recipient of the prestigious medal, Dr. Angelou joins a distinguished roster of African Americans who have received the Award including last year's winner Dr. Dorothy Height. Other medalists include Barbara Jordan, General Colin Powell, Rev. Jesse Jackson, Bill Cosby and former Los Angeles Mayor Tom Bradley.

a book and we were going to market the book over a 1-900 line." At no time were investors promised payments based upon the performance of the book, adds Thomas. "These were considered personal loans." The state of Nevada disagreed. He received a call from the Securities Division of the State Attorney General's office which informed him he had been accused of selling securities without a license.

In the original complaint, the state emphatically requested felony charges, yet downgraded all charges to misdemeanor convictions during a subsequent plea bargain. Thomas refused the plea bargain citing discontent with the original charges which he called merely a fabricated attempt to discredit him. "They are either going to give

find satisfaction within the state system to resolve the matter. "You cannot resolve your grievances within the department," says Jackson. "You have to go to channel 8 or other media." Jackson has had his complaints featured on KCEP FM 88's Police in the Community radio talk show, Channel 8, and in an article carried by the Las Vegas Review-Journal which featured the department's hiring practices. He adds that the promotions within the system are primarily based upon cronyism. "If you're the type of individual who will lie down and do their bidding-their concept of a team player-then you will be rewarded."
