Nathan Adelson Hospice 2nd Annual Golf Tournament Slated For September 9 At Sahara CC

The Nathan Adelson Hospice, a community supported agency providing care to terminally ill patients, will hold their 2nd annual golf tournament at the Sahara Country Club on September 9. The entry fee is \$200 per person while there is a \$300 tee sponsorship. The entry deadline is September 2.

The registration and continental breakfast will commence at 7:00 a.m. and conclude at 7:50 a.m. There is an 8:00 a.m. shotgun start.

Complimentary gifts will be given to each participant and there will be a luncheon at the Country Club following the tournament.

The tournament is limited to 144 people.

The Hospice's care focuses on extending comfort measures and support in an effort to enhance quality of life, reduce stress, and pre-

pare a patient and family for impending death. The Hospice program also provides bereavement support for a patient's family for up to 13 months after the death.

In 1993, over 700 terminally ill patients were admitted to the Hospice program, and over 500 of their loved ones accessed services provided by Hospice staff and volunteers. Volunteers gave nearly 12,000 hours of service to the Hospice.

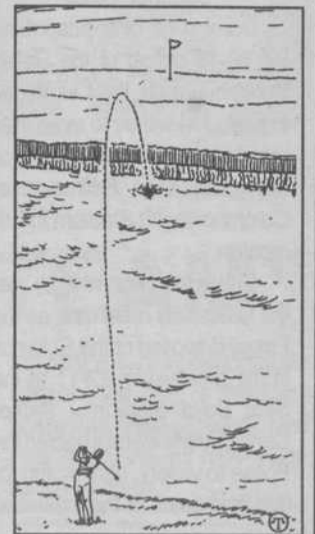
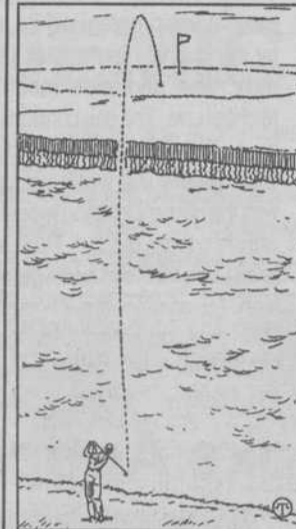

Mental—Take Enough Club

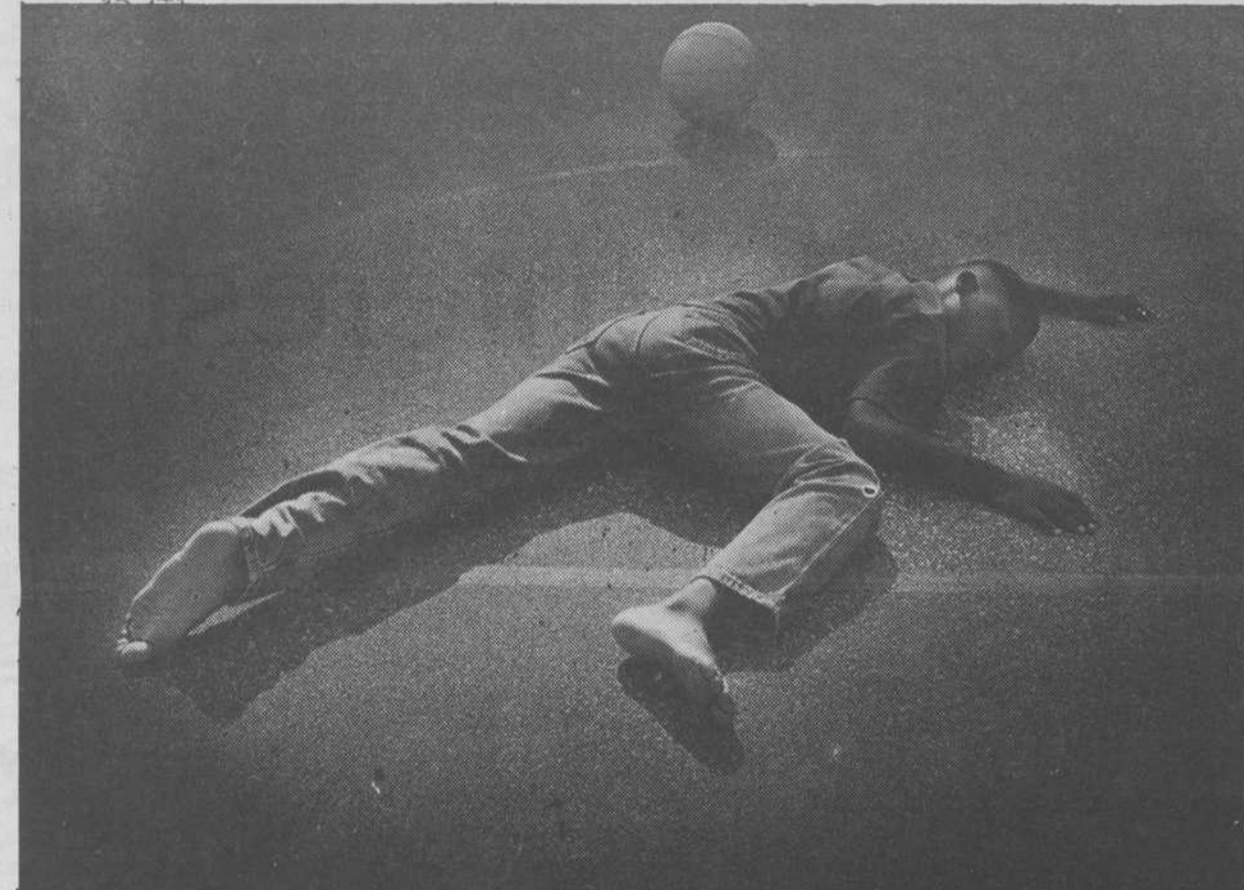


Today's Tip
On most golf courses you'll find that 80 percent of the hazards (bunkers, water, mounding, etc.) are positioned on the front half of the green. With that in mind we

should discuss the mental approach of taking enough club to reach the green or hit the back fringe.

Club selection plays a key role in getting there. Why do most people not hit the proper club for a given length? Because most golfers do not know how far they REALLY hit the club.

Say for instance with a perfect stroke of your five-iron the ball carries a maximum of 150 yards. So if you are 150+ yards from the green, only a perfect shot will get you to the pin. Why not use one more club? It works. Touring professionals do it and you should, too.

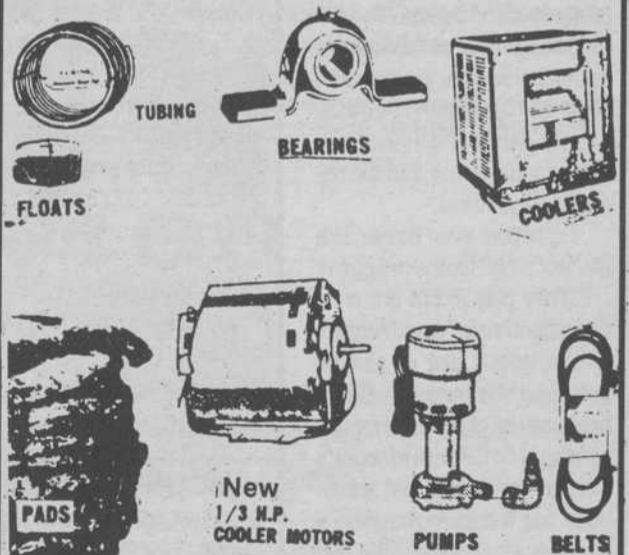
