British blues legend John Mayall and the Bluesbreakers will headline the Third Annual Las Vegas Blues and Heritage Festival, Saturday, October 8, 1994 from 11:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. at Sunset Park. Also appearing are the Jimmy McGriff/Hank Crawford Quartet; Saffire, the Uppity Blueswomen; Jimmy Johnson; and the Las Vegas Kings featuring Scott Rhiner.

Tickets are \$8 in advance, \$10 at the gate. Children under 12 are free with an adult. Tickets are available through Ticketmaster or through Clark County Parks and Recreation.

There will be a free craft area for children. Food vendors will offer a variety of menus, and beer and wine will be for sale. The Festival site offers plenty of free parking.

Festival goers may bring picnics and factory-sealed beverages, but no alcohol, open containers, glass, pets or videocameras are allowed. Coolers will be checked at the gate.
