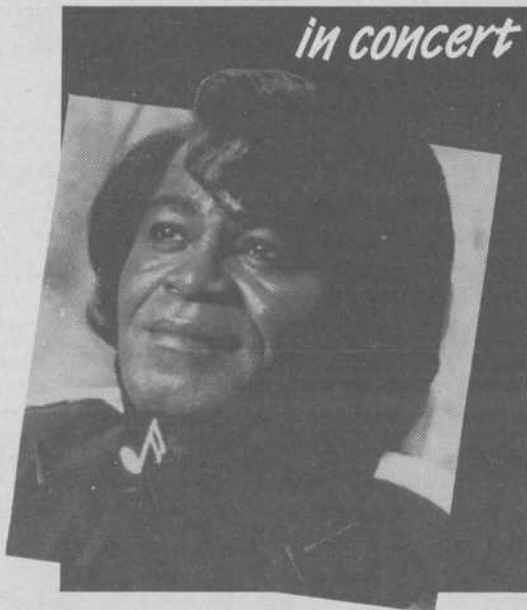
working on a charcoal drawing for Superior Court Judge LaDoris Cordell that will be held at the d.p. Fona Galleries in December.
