TARTING early in the 70's, magnet schools and programs were created as vehicles for voluntary desegregation in public schools across the nation. By providing unique educational programs absent in neighborhood schools, the establishment of magnet schools and programs is a way to offer students opportunities to choose educational experiences based on their special interests and abilities.

YPES of Magnets: A magnet program serves a specific number of students from more than one attendance area, in a school that also provides a regular program to students in a specific attendance area. A magnet school is a school which serves more than one attendance area, with the total school population participating in the identified magnet program. Magnet schools offer unique instructional programs related to the magnet theme to all student attending the school.

DMISSION Requirements: Students and parents may choose from the magnet schools and magnet programs offered by the Clark County School District based on the interest, talent, and abilities. Application forms are available at each of the magnet sites. The "window period for submitting an application for enrollment in a magnet school/program for the following school year has been established:

for Elementary Magnet Schools & Programs - January through the Third Friday in February for Secondary Magnet Schools & Programs - January through the First Friday in March Notification of acceptance is generally made by the Second Friday in March for the elementary magnet schools & programs, and no later than the First Friday in May for the secondary magnet schools & programs. When the number of eligible students for a magnet school or program exceeds the number of seats available, a random selection method will be utilized. In keeping with the district's goals, racial balance is a consideration in selecting students for magnet schools and programs.

HE district currently has ten magnet schools & programs in operation. To reduce racial isolation and improve academic achievement, Clark County School District has receive a two-year, 3.4 million dollar federal grant from the Magnet Schools Assistance Program, which provides funding for additional staff and technological equipment for identified magnet schools. The ten magnet schools include the following:
